

Terms of Reference 2021

The Child and Family Collaborative (C&FC) is a community of professionals in York Region who work with children prenatal to twelve years, in the early years sector. Committed to principles of prevention and education, C&FC creates opportunities for networking, professional development, life-long learning, research, planning, early identification and intervention, and an ongoing investment in the early years.

This community of professionals are invited to attend in-person or virtual meetings, a minimum of 3 times per year, where they can engage, share skills, knowledge, experience, and enthusiasm.

The C&FC website (www.cfcollaborative.ca) is a common access point for information and linkages, professional development, and employment recruitment and retention.

Goals

- Provide resources to support early years professionals and families with children prenatal to twelve vears
- Bring individuals, groups, and organizations together to support a strong, inclusive, cohesive and sustainable early years system that supports diversity, accessibility and quality
- Plan and implement professional development, including an annual conference
- Liaise and provide input to funders and policymakers within the various ministries
- Collaborate with regional and municipal governments, school boards and community partners to identify community gaps
- Maintains linkages to other relevant planning tables and networks
